Step 1: Planning & Design

	Define your budget (include 10–20% buffer for unexpected costs).

	Pick tiles, paint colors, and other materials.	
	Finalize layout (consult a designer if needed).	
	Order materials to avoid delays (tiles, vanity, fixtures).	
	Hire a contractor or confirm DIY plan.

	Check local regulations for required permits (plumbing, electrical, structural).	
	Submit permit applications to your city or county.
